School Perceptions Survey - Students Grades 5-12

Each year to inform our ongoing improvement efforts and strategic planning, we survey students in grades 5-12. Traditionally, we have conducted this survey with the Gallup Student Poll Survey. This year, we are utilizing a new tool that will give us information more specific to our district and building needs. This survey asks questions about their school experience, academics, programming, extra-curricular opportunities, and connections to school. The survey does not ask them to rate or assess individual teachers or school employees.

The company providing our new survey is School Perceptions. We chose this provider over Gallup because they allow us to customize questions for our district, provide a consistent analysis tool, provide a product that allows us to see trends at the grade and classroom level, and the survey is distributed to students directly via district email.

The survey will launch November 4. Students will receive an introductory email from their building principal and me explaining the purpose of the survey prior to the survey launch. If you have any questions or concerns about the survey, please contact your school's principal or administrative contact. The communication will look like the following from School Perceptions to your student's email:
