SCHOOL ABSENCES DURING ONLINE LEARNING

WAIVER APPROVED

College Community School District received notification from the Iowa Department of Education that our waiver to move to temporary online learning starting November 16 and ending November 24 has been granted. Waivers for online instruction through the Iowa Department of Education are only granted for two week increments. We continue to plan for an every-other-day hybrid learning model for all students PK-12 November 30 through December 22 (winter break).
